It took Paula Vogel about seven years to write *Indecent*. The development of the play started in 2010, when Ms. Vogel first collaborated with director Rebecca Taichman, who was researching *God of Vengeance* as part of her graduate thesis at Yale School of Drama.

Vogel meticulously researched the historical context and worked closely with Taichman through workshops and staged readings before the play premiered in 2015 at Yale Repertory Theatre. This long development period reflects the depth of historical and artistic exploration necessary to bring *Indecent* to life with its blend of fact, imagination, and theatricality.
